Born January 10, 1929 under the pen name of Hergé, Tintin is more than ever a global icon. More than 275 million albums sold in 110 national, regional and dialectal languages; several feature films including *The Secret of The Unicorn* from Steven Spielberg and animated series for the small screen; products derived from quality drawings, the record sale, sold at more than 2,500,000 € for the original drawings of cover pages in India ink.

Hergé said: "Tintin's universe is optimistic". Today more than ever, his adventures captivate. Reading allows each of us to escape the world and relax and it puts us in a good mood. We all have in us something from Tintin. It is the centre of a complex universe that brings us back to our own reality.

This 90th is an opportunity to reaffirm the universal values of Tintin throughout the year 2019, with a programme bringing together digital albums, reports, exhibitions and animations, here's a taste:

• The second adventure of the little reporter, *Tintin in the Congo*, is the subject of a new digital edition, closer to the line of Hergé, starting from the original plates, that have been fully restored and colorized according to the techniques of the 21st century.

- The Royal Mint of Belgium will devote a coin of five euros to Tintin
- For the tenth anniversary of his museum, Hergé will be honoured.
